

LEGENDARY SOFTBALL'S CAMP & CLINIC REFUND POLICY

All Legendary Softball Camps and Clinics have a **non-refundable** deposit fee of 25%. This deposit is **non-refundable** regardless of withdrawal from or cancellation of events and is not eligible to be refunded. The deposit will be subtracted from the full event registration fee.

If the camp is cancelled due to weather or an unforeseen circumstance, including but not limited to, natural disasters, severe weather events, epidemics, pandemics, quarantines, war, or Acts of God; we will issue a credit to another camp of **equal or lesser value** to be used within the next **6** months. The Non-Refundable deposit amount will be assessed.

Should there be restrictions placed on our staff from their respective school, governing bodies (conferences or NCAA) or personal reasons, there will be no refunds. At our discretion and under certain circumstances, we will provide a credit for another camp of equal or lesser value within the next **6** months. The non-refundable deposit amount will be assessed.

- For the Fall Player, D2/D3 or Coaches Clinics- **NO REFUNDS** will be issued for **ANY** reason within **21** days of the event.
- For the Summer Mid Atlantic Player Clinic- **NO REFUNDS** will be issued for **ANY** reason within **40** DAYS of the EVENT.

This policy INCLUDES, but not limited to, injury, travel issues, team location changes or early commitments AND reasons listed in above paragraphs.

No player substitutions within **21 DAYS** for all player camps and clinics.

Should a player need to withdraw, requests must be submitted in writing (emails will be considered written) and in the appropriate time frame to be considered. No telephone messages will be accepted.

All approved camp, clinic and player showcase refunds or credits are subject to the 25% non-refundable deposit.

Please Note: The success of Legendary Softball camps, clinic and individual showcase events for its participants requires months of administrative planning, securing fields and staffing, renting and purchasing supplies along with other associated costs in preparation. These expenses are incurred regardless of extenuating circumstances. Therefore, it is necessary to have these refund policies in place.
